The responsibilities of the Auditor will include the planning and execution of statutory audits of the annual accounts of the EFSF in accordance with the EFSF Consolidated Articles of Association (Article 15) and all applicable provisions of the laws of Luxembourg, including the Audit Profession Law. The auditors may have to travel to Brussels to report to the EFSF governing bodies.
